

## Family Worship Guide March 22, 2020

Our devotional this morning introduces us to a new character in Genesis, Abram. God will use Abram to mediate his covenant promise to restore His kingdom on earth. We will learn about the promise that God made to Abram and how God kept his promise in Jesus Christ. As we are reminded in 2 Corinthians 1.20, "For all the promises of God find their Yes in Christ. That is why it is through him that we utter our Amen to God for his glory." As Christians, our hope rests in Christ, the fulfillment of God's promise.
